Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. This docket should remain open pending remittance of the settlement amount. Telaleasing will have five business days from issuance of the Commission's order to submit the settlement. Any collected monies should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285 (i), Florida Statutes. If Telaleasing fails to pay the settlement amount, the Commission should require Telaleasing to show cause why its certificate should not be canceled for failure to comply with the Commission's rules and orders.
