Issue 1: Should the Commission impose a \$500 fine or cancel Reliable Pay-Phone Communications, Inc.'s Pay Telephone Certificate Number 4171 for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should impose a \$500 fine or cancel Reliable Pay-Phone Communications, Inc.'s certificate if the fine and the regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalties and interest, are not received by the Commission within five business days after the conclusion of the 21-day protest period. The fine should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the Commission's order is not protested and the fine and regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalties and interest, are not received, the pay telephone certificate should be canceled with an effective date of December 31, 1998.

<u>Issue 2</u>: Should the Commission impose a \$10,000 fine or cancel Reliable Pay-Phone Communications, Inc.'s Pay Telephone Certificate Number 4171 for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code, Response to Commission Staff Inquiries?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should impose a \$10,000 fine or cancel the company's Certificate Number 4171 if the company does not respond to staff's request for information as required by Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code and the fine is not received by the Commission within five business days after the conclusion of the 21-day protest period. The fine should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the Commission's order is not protested and the required response and fine are not received, Pay Telephone Certificate Number 4171 should be canceled with an effective date of December 31, 1998.

Issue 3: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. If no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of the issuance date of the order, the order will become final. Upon payment of the fines and fees, or cancellation of the certificate, this docket should be closed.
