Dear Lifetime Lessee:

This letter is to advise you that it appears that your current water consumption indicates excessive usage, perhaps because of undetected leak(s), or other waste. The average household uses up to 4-6,000 gallons per month, and your current meter reading is for 10,000 gallons.

We recommend that you check your connections and plumbing to ensure that there are no leaks, particularly if you have not been doing much outdoor watering. A leaky toilet, or one that runs between flushes, dripping faucets (including outside spigots), or water running or dripping underneath the home, etc. will waste a great deal of water.

We have several "handy-man" residents that make such repairs. If you would like names, or other assistance to cure a water problem, please contact this office.
