Issue 2: Should the docket be closed?

Recommendation: If Issue 1 is approved, this tariff should become effective on or after the stamped approval date of the tariff sheets, pursuant to Rule 25-30.475, Florida Administrative Code. If a protest is filed within 21 days of issuance of the Order, this tariff should remain in effect with any increase held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest and the docket should remain open. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed upon the issuance of a Consummating Order.
