

MOTION TO ACCEPT FILING OF REBUTTAL TESTIMONY

Pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, F.A.C., Sprint Spectrum L.P. d/b/a Sprint PCS ("Sprint PCS") requests that the FPSC accept its rebuttal testimony (witnesses Mitchell, Hunsucker, Farrar and Sabatino) for filing one day late, and says:

- 1. The procedural schedule in this case called for rebuttal testimony to be filed on or before December 13, 2000.
- 2. Due to unavoidable delays reproducing its rebuttal testimony, Sprint PCS' rebuttal testimony did not arrive by hand delivery at the Division of Records and Reporting until a few minutes after 5:00 p.m. on December 13th. Since the Division of Records and Reporting was closed, the rebuttal testimony was filed with the Division of Records and Reporting at 8:31 a.m. on December 14, 2000.
