On June 9, 2000, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed a Request for Confidential Classification of certain information contained in TECO's Commercial/Industrial Service Rider (CISR) report for the quarter ended March 31, 2000, Document No. 07092-00. The report was filed in accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-98-1081-FOF-EI, issued August 10, 1998, Order Approving Commercial Industrial Service Rider and Pilot Study Implementation Plan for Tampa Electric Company. TECO asserts that certain information contained in the report is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. TECO contends that the information for which confidential classification is requested is intended to be and is treated by TECO as private and has not been publicly disclosed.

TECO specifically requested confidential classification for three items. Item No. (1) contains the negotiated Contract Service Agreement (CSA) rate; Item No. (2) contains annual revenues from the customer; and Item No. (3) contains the escalation rate of the negotiated rate. Staff agrees with TECO's assertion that the release of the information contained in the report could cause harm to both TECO and the customer that has entered into the CSA. At the present time, TECO has only one customer with which it has negotiated a CSA contract under the CISR tariff. Public disclosure of the information would impair TECO's ability to negotiate terms and conditions in future CSAs that are favorable to TECO and its customers.

Staff recommends that the information referenced in Document No. 07092-00 be granted confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes.

A sophisticated member of the public could use the information to estimate the amount of the discount provided to the entity and use it to its own advantage, especially in any CISR negotiations with TECO. The future need for confidentiality will diminish if at least three entities enter into CSA contracts.

Staff recommends that the information referenced in Document No. 13074-00 be granted confidential classification pursuant to §366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.
