**PETITION FOR DESIGNATION AS AN ELIGIBLE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER IN THE STATE OF GEORGIA
(NO RURAL REDEFINITION REQUESTED)**

Global Connection, Inc. of America pursuant to Section 214(e)(2) of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act") ⁽¹⁾ and Sections 54.101 through 54.207 of the Rules of the Federal Communication Commission ("FCC"),⁽²⁾ hereby petitions the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") in certain BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon exchanged as described herein ("Designated Area") for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support. As demonstrated below, Global Connection, Inc. of America satisfies all of the statutory and regulatory requirements for designation as an ETC in the Designated Area. Furthermore, designation of Global Connection, Inc. of America in the Designated Area will serve the public interest. Accordingly, Global Connection, Inc. of America respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition.

I. Background

I. Global Connection, Inc. of America is a Georgia corporation ⁽³⁾ and is authorized to conduct business as a foreign corporation in the State of Florida. ⁽⁴⁾ Copies of the Company's Articles of Incorporation and authority to transact business in the State of Florida are on file with the Commission and incorporated herein by reference.⁽⁵⁾ The Company has been certified by the Commission as a Competitive Local Exchange Company ("CLEC") in Florida (Certificate No. 7830). The principle office of the Company is located at 3957 Pleasantdale Road, Atlanta, Georgia 30362-1269. The Company provides local exchange and exchange access services in the BellSouth, Sprint, Verizon, AT&T and SBC exchanges using a combination of unbundled network elements ("UNEs") provided by these companies that allows end-to-end switching delivery of calls.

II. As set forth in Section 214(e)(2) of the Act, the Commission "shall upon its own motion or upon request designate a common carrier that meets the requirements of [Section 214(e)(1)] as an eligible telecommunications carrier for a service area designated by the State commission." ⁽⁶⁾ Upon designation as an ETC, the carrier shall be eligible to receive universal support in accordance with Section 254 of the Act. ⁽⁷⁾

III. The requirements for designation as an ETC set forth in Section 214(e)(1) are that the carrier must:

- (A) offer the services that are supported by Federal universal support mechanisms under section 254(c), either using its own facilities or a combination of its own facilities and resale of another carrier's services (including the services offered by another eligible telecommunications carrier); and
- (B) advertise the availability of such services and the charges therefore using the media of general distribution. ⁽⁸⁾

II. Global Connection, Inc. of America Satisfies the Requirements for Designation as an ETC to Serve the Designated Area

IV. Global Connection, Inc. of America is a common carrier as that term is defined in the Act.⁽⁹⁾ The Company provides competitive local telecommunications services in the state of Florida in accordance with Certificate No. 7830 and Florida Public Service Commission Tariff No. 1, which was first effective on June 28, 2001.¹⁰

V. Global Connection, Inc. of America offers all of the supported services enumerated under Section 254(c) using facilities obtained as UNEs from BellSouth, Sprint, Verizon, Alltel, SBC and AT&T. According to FCC Rules, facilities obtained as UNEs satisfy the requirement that an ETC provide the supported services using either its own facilities or a combination of its own facilities and resale of another carrier's services. (11) Accordingly, the company satisfies the requirement set forth in Section 214(e)(1)(A).

VI. The services that are supported by Federal universal support mechanisms under section 254(c) are enumerated in the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") at 47 C.F.R. § 54.101(a)(1)-(9). There services are:

a) Voice grade access to the public switched network. "Voice grade access" is defined as a functionality that enables a user of telecommunication services to transmit voice communications, including signaling the network that the caller wishes to place a call, and to receive voice communications, including receiving a signal indicating there is an incoming call. For the purposes of this part, bandwidth for voice grade access should be, at a minimum, 300 to 3,000 Hertz;

Global Connection, Inc. of America use of BellSouth's, Sprint's, and Verizon's UNEs meets this definition of "facilities."

(b) Local usage. “Local usage” means an amount of minutes of use of exchange service, prescribed by the FCC, provided free of charge to end-users;

(c) Dual tone multi-frequency signaling or its functional equivalent. “Dual tone multi-frequency” (DTMF) is a method of signaling that facilitates the transportation of signaling through the network, shortening call set-up time;

(d) Single-party or its functional equivalent. “Single-party service” is telecommunications service that permits users to have exclusive use of wireless subscriber loop or access line for each call placed, or, in the case of wireless telecommunications carriers, which use spectrum shared among users to provide service, a dedicated message path for the length of a user’s particular transmission;

(e) Access to emergency services. “Access to emergency services” includes access to services, such as 911 and enhanced 911, provided by local governments or other public safety organizations. 911 is defined as a service that permits a telecommunications user, by dialing the three-digit code “911,” to call emergency services through a Public Service Access Point (PSAP) operated by the local government. “Enhanced 911” is defined as 911 service that includes the ability to provide automatic numbering information (ANI), which enables the PSAP to call back if the call is disconnected, and automatic location information (ALI), which permits emergency service providers to

identify the geographic location of the calling party. "Access to emergency services" includes access to 911 and enhanced 911 services to the extent the local government in a eligible carrier's service area has implemented 911 or enhanced 911 systems;

(f) Access to the operator services. "Access to operator services" is defined as access to any automatic or live assistance to a consumer to arrange for billing or completion, or both, of a telephone call;

(g) Access to interchange service. "Access to interchange service" is defined as the use of the loop, as well as that portion of the switch that is paid for by the end user, or the functional equivalent of these network elements in the case of a wireless carrier, necessary to access an interchange carrier's network;

(h) Access to directory assistance. "Access to directory assistance" is defined as access to a service that includes, but is not limited to. Making available to customers, upon request, information contained in directory listings; and

(i) Toll limitation for qualifying low-income consumers. Toll limitation for qualifying low-income consumers.

VII. Upon designation as an ETC, Global Connection, Inc. of America will participate in, and offer, LifeLine and Link-Up programs to qualifying low-income consumers and publicize the availability of LifeLine and Link-Up services in a manner reasonably designed to reach those likely to qualify for those services, as required by FCC Rules (12).

Attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference are copies of Global Connection, Inc. of America proposed LifeLine and Link-Up tariff to be filed with the Commission upon approval.

VIII. Global Connection, Inc. of America will advertise the availability of the above-referenced services and the charges for those services in the Designated Area using media of general distribution, as required by FCC Rules ⁽¹³⁾.

IX. Attached as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference are Global Connection, Inc. of America updated financial statements demonstrating that the Company has the financial qualifications to provide the services specified herein. Global Connection, Inc. of America has previously provided the Commission with evidence of its financial capabilities to provide the supported services in context of its application to become certified as a CLEC in Docket No. 9322-U. The financial statements of Global Connection, Inc. of America contain proprietary and confidential information not generally available to the public. The financial statements of Global Connection, Inc. of America contain proprietary and confidential information not generally available to the public and thus have been marked confidential and are being submitted under seal to be maintained by the Commission and

Commission staff on a confidential basis pursuant to current Commission rules.

- X. Attached as Exhibit C and incorporated herein by reference is a current list of officers. Global Connection, Inc. of America has previously provided the Commission with evidence of its managerial and technical capabilities to provide the supported services in context of its application to become certified as a CLEC
- XI. Attached as Exhibit D to this Petition and incorporated herein by reference is the testimony of Houssam Abdallah, President of Global Connection, Inc. of America certifying that the Company satisfies all of the requirements for designation as an ETC to serve the Designated Area.

III. Area for Which ETC Designation is requested

- XII. Global Connection, Inc. of America has served and will continue to serve the exchanges where it leases UNEs or resells the services of the non-rural telephone companies, BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon in the state of Florida. Global Connection, Inc. of America does not seek designation as an ETC in any areas served by rural telephone companies. Pursuant to the Order in Docket No. 9322-U, the Company does not provide local exchange service in any area served by an independent telephone company as defined in the Second Amendatory Interim Certificate of Authority dated October 10, 2001. The exchanges in the BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon service areas that

Global Connection, Inc. of America serves and for which it seeks ETC designation are attached as Exhibit E.

IV. Granting Global Connection, Inc. of America Petition will Serve the Public Interest

XIII. Congress requires that the Commission grant competitive ETC petitions in non-rural areas ⁽¹⁴⁾. No specific public interest test is mentioned, as is the case for areas served by rural telephone companies ⁽¹⁵⁾. Thus, the Act provides that the Commission “shall” designate Global Connection, Inc. of America as an ETC upon finding that the company meets the nine-point list of services and that it agrees to advertise the supported services throughout the designated service area. Notwithstanding, the designation of Global Connection, Inc. of America as an ETC will serve the public interest.

XIV. A central purpose of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 was to “promote competition and reduce regulation ... [thereby securing] lower prices and higher quality services ... and encourage the rapid deployment of new telecommunications technologies.”⁽¹⁶⁾ Designation of Global Connection, Inc. of America as an ETC would further these goals. Granting ETC status to Global Connection, Inc. of America would allow the Company to obtain federal universal service support, which it will use

to offer innovative telecommunications services at competitive prices to rural consumers in the BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon service areas.

- XV. Global Connection, Inc. of America will announce and advertise telecommunications services as an ETC where it provides service in the BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon service areas in Florida and will publicize the availability of Lifeline and Link-Up services in a manner reasonably designed to reach those likely to qualify for those services. Accordingly, more low-income Florida residents will be made aware of the opportunities afforded to them under the Lifeline and Link-Up programs and will be able to take advantage of those opportunities by subscribing to Global Connection, Inc. of America service.

For the foregoing reasons, Global Connection, Inc. of America respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition and designate the Company as an ETC for the BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon exchanged specified herein.

Exhibit A

G. Lifeline

1. Applicability:

- a. Lifeline discounts are applicable to local exchange services provided to eligible residential Applicants.

2. Territory:

- a. Within the base rate areas of all BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon exchanges as shown and defined in the Incumbent LEC's current and effective Tariffs on file with the Commission.

3. Discounts:

- a. Lifeline is provided as a reduction of the subscriber's access line rate for local service in amounts equal to the sum of the state and/or federal approved and supported credits.

4. Terms and Conditions:

- a. Lifeline is provided only to the customer's principle residence
- b. One low-income credit is available per household and applicable to the primary residential connection only. The names subscriber must be a current recipient of any of the low-income assistance programs identified in 5 following.
- c. Proof of eligibility in any of the qualifying low-income assistance programs should be provided to the Company at the time of application for service. The Lifeline credit will not be established until the Company has received proof of eligibility.
- d. When, for any reason, a customer is determined to be ineligible the Company will contact the customer. If the customer cannot provide eligibility documentation, the Lifeline account will be disconnected.
- e. Certification of eligibility in any of the qualifying low-income assistance programs will be required for any account that has been disconnected prior to the

reestablishment of the service.

5. Eligible low-income assistance programs:

- a. The eligible low-income assistance programs are the same as those defined in the Incumbent LEC's current and effective Tariffs on file with the Commission..

H. Link-Up

1.Link-Up is a connection assistance programs, which provides for the reduction of applicable charges associated with connection of telephone service.

2. The applicant must meet the requirements for qualification for Lifeline Telephone Service.

MANAGEMENT and TECHNICAL TEAM

Houssam Abdallah established Global Connection Inc. of America in June 1998. He serves as its President/CEO and is involved in ensuring regulatory compliance. He has an Industrial Engineering degree. Global Connection Inc. of America has current subscription of approximately 13,000 lines and monthly revenues of over \$600,000.

Prior to such, he created and continues to operate Southeast Dental Care, Inc. ("S.E.D.C.") a regional Dental / Optical / Chiropractic Plan which is primarily directed to income groups not utilizing conventional insurance coverage. S.E.D.C. was founded in 1994 and has expanded to multi-state operations. Mr. Abdallah has extensive experience in the management of sales personnel and identification of market potential.

Bassam Abdallah, Vice President and the Director of Management Information Systems, has extensive experience in the field of technology platforms for administration of commercial operations. Mr. Abdallah has a B.S. degree in Computer Science and over 20 years experience in the set up and design of technical infrastructure. Mr. Abdallah is presently interacting with software engineers to develop the back office technology platform which will allow Global to interface with primary carriers, payment centers and customers on a virtual basis to allow for efficiency in the management of service and account maintenance.

Maxine Alagar is the Director of Center Operations. She came to Global after thirty-four and a half years Telephony experience with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth). Her extensive background and knowledge gained is indicated throughout her positions held in both Louisiana and Alabama during pre and post divestiture of South Central Bell and AT&T. Maxine began her career with technical experience as an Operator in Operator Services, a Frame Attendant in Central Offices for Step-by-Step, Cross Bar, and #5 ESS Switching Services and as a Customer Service Representative in Interconnection Customer Service Center (ICSC). She next advanced to an Assistant Manager in the ICSC Provisioning Center; then an Assistant Manager for Wide Area Telephone Service (WATS) Billing in New Orleans, La.; then a Special Access Staff Manager in Alabama. Maxine later held positions as an Assistant Manager Billing and Collections, Collections Director and at the time she had retired, Maxine was the Operations Director of Billing and Collections for BellSouth Accounts Receivables Management in Birmingham, Alabama. 

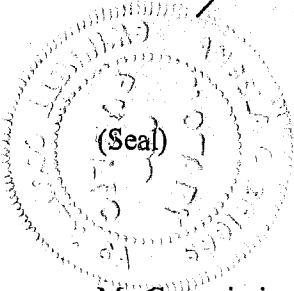



NOTE 1- SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Company's Activities and Operating Cycle: Global Connection, Inc. of America is a Sub Chapter S type Corporation with a single shareholder. The Company is licensed by th Georgia Public Service Commission as a reseller of telecommunications services in the State of Georgia. The Company is also licensed in Kentucky, Texas, Alabama, North Carolina, Arkansas, Indiana, Florida, Michigan Mississippi, South Carolina, Tennessee, Wisconsin, Illinois, Kansas and Ohio. The Company began its operations in May of 1988. The Company provides credit in the normal course of business to its customers and performs ongoing credit evaluations of those customers. It maintains allowances for doubtful accounts based on factors surrounding the credit risk of specific customers, historical trends, and other information.

Income taxes. The corporation is organized as a subchapter S type corporation. As a subchapter the corporation makes no provision for either Federal or State Federal or State income taxes. Deferred taxes are composed of communication taxes.

Cash and Cash Equivalents. For purposes of reporting cash flows, cash is defined as cash on hand, deposits, and amounts held at financial institutions.

Estimated in Financial Statements. The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosures of contingent liabilities at the date the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

NOTE-2 PLANT AND EQUIPMENT

The Company depreciates its assets utilizing the straightline half year convention.

NOTE 5 INVESTMENTS RECEIVABLE

The Company invests what it determines to be excess cash balances at the end of each month with financial institutions. The investments are returned to the company at the beginning of the nex month, usually within a three day period.

NOTE 6 CONCENTRATION OF CREDIT RISK

The Company maintains several accounts at banking institutions. Accounts at these institutions are insured by the Federal Depository Insurance Corporation (FDIC) for up to \$100,000. Cash at financial institutions exceeded this limit by \$288,432.
