Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. ("AUF") by and through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to §367.156, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this Motion for Temporary Protective Order regarding certain documents and information as set forth below. As grounds for its request, AUF states as follows:

1. OPC has propounded numerous discovery requests on AUF. AUF has determined that certain documents and information responsive to OPC's Interrogatories Nos. 35 and 96 contain or constitute confidential, proprietary business information belonging to AUF pursuant to §367.156, Florida Statutes. The information is owned and controlled by AUF and is intended to be and is treated by AUF as confidential. Further, disclosure of the information would impair AUF's competitive business and impair AUF's efforts to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.

2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6), Florida Administrative Code, AUF requests a temporary protective order exempting the information from §119.07(1), Florida Statutes in order to allow OPC to inspect or take possession of such confidential information for the purpose of determining what information is to be used in this proceeding. As required by Rule 25-22.006(6), AUF will file a specific request for a protective order if the information is to be used in this proceeding.
