Commission staff has reviewed the July 18, 2014, response from North Peninsula Utilities Corp. (NPUC) concerning deficiencies in its application. The application is still incomplete until the following deficiencies have been corrected.

Deficiencies

1. **Notice of Application for Amendment.** Per Rule 25-30.030, (8) F.A.C., 8) A copy of the notice(s) and list of the entities receiving notice pursuant to this rule shall accompany the affidavit required by Sections 367.045(1)(e) and (2)(f), F.S. The affidavit shall be filed no later than 15 days after filing the application. The response did not provide the required affidavits that confirm the utility has properly given notice.
2. **Notice of Application for Increase in Service Availability.** Rule 25-30.565(2), F.A.C., requires upon filing an application for a new or revised service availability charge or policy, the utility shall provide notice pursuant to Rule 25-30.4345, F.A.C. This notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the service areas included in the petition. Furthermore, the Utility shall provide notices to all persons in the service areas who have filed a written request for service or been provided a written estimate within 12 months prior to the month the application was filed. Please provide a copy of the notices issued in regards to the service availability application and affidavits indicating that noticing was completed.
