FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information contained in the prepared testimony of FPL witness Tom L. Hartman (TLH-2) and David Herr (DH-3) in this proceeding. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. On March 6, 2015, FPL filed the testimony of FPL witnesses Tom Hartman and David Herr in support of FPL's Petition for Approval of Arrangement To Mitigate Impact of Unfavorable Cedar Bay Power Purchase Obligation. Exhibit TLH-2 to the testimony of Tom Hartman and Exhibit DH-3 to the testimony of David Herr contain confidential information. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 FPL files this Request for Confidential Classification.
 - 2. The following exhibits are included with this Request:
- a. Exhibit A consists of a copy of the confidential material on which all of the information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted.
- b. Exhibit B consists of pages identifying the title of the exhibits and noting that the contents are confidential. Because FPL seeks confidential classification of the exhibits in their entirety, no purpose would be served by reproducing a full redacted version.
- c. Exhibit C is a table that identifies the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affiants who support the requested classification.

- d. Exhibit D is comprised of the affidavits of Tom Hartman and David Herr in support of this Request for Confidential Classification.
- 3. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determined that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the hard of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 4. As the affidavits included as Exhibit D indicate, some of the information provided by FPL contains information concerning contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. Other information includes proprietary information concerning the competitive interest of FPL or third parties, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e).
- 5. Exhibit TLH-2 contains information related to the specific negotiated terms between FPL and CBAS Holdings, LLC for the Cedar Bay Transaction, the disclosure of which would impair FPL's ability or position to attain favorable transactions for the benefit of its customers in the future. Likewise, disclosure would impair CBAS Holdings, LLC's ability to negotiate terms with third parties indirectly affected by the Cedar Bay Transaction. Such information is protected by Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S.

6. Exhibit DH-3 contains information is related to the competitive interests of Duff & Phelps, Inc., an independent valuation consultant. Exhibit DH-3 consists of a highly detailed valuation assessment prepared by Duff & Phelps, which, if disclosed, would reveal the proprietary methodology that Duff & Phelps employs in performing valuations. Such public disclosure would impair the competitive businesses of Duff & Phelps.

7. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Confidential Information is proprietary confidential business information within Section 366.093(3), such information should not be declassified for at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavits included herewith, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
