> As residents of Indian River Shores, we urge you to decide favorably  
> concerning our petition to the PSC to have our town's service  
> boundaries re-drawn so that the entire town can be serviced by FPL  
> instead of only those residents who reside north of Old Winter Beach  
> Road.  
> Indian River Shores residents should not have to pay significantly

> higher and unregulated utility rates which have been forced upon us by  
> the town of Vero Beach in order to subsidize its own operation.  
> As you know FPL has offered to buy the utility system for Indian River  
> Shores and is ready to service our needs. We feel strongly that as  
> residents of the town and Florida citizens, we are entitled to pay  
> only rates that are professionally and neutrally regulated by the PSC  
> as would be the case with FPL.  
> It is unfair and unacceptable that the city of Vero Beach continues to  
> impose an excessive and unregulated rate burden on part of our  
> community. We have no representation in Vero Beach town government and  
> no recourse to rectify this egregious overreach of municipal  
> boundaries. Please support our request and put an end to this problem  
> for our community.
