TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or the "company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby requests an extension of the confidential classification granted to certain information contained the company's Microgrid Pilot Annual Report (June 7, 2022 through May 31, 2023). In support thereof, the company says:

- 1. On September 12, 2023, Tampa Electric filed a Request for Confidential Classification ("Request") (DN 05185-2023) for certain information contained the company's Microgrid Pilot Annual Report (June 7, 2022 through May 31, 2023), as it constitutes "proprietary confidential business information" under Section 366.96(3), Florida Statutes.
- 2. On December 20, 2023, the Commission entered Order No. PSC-2023-0378-CFO-EI in Docket No. 20200234-EI, which granted Tampa Electric's Request. Pursuant to that Order, the period of confidential classification will expire on June 20, 2025.
- 3. Tampa Electric submits that the confidential information subject to the original Request continues to be "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 366.96(3), Florida Statutes. More specifically, the information subject to the Request consists of costs incurred by BlockEnergy to operate and maintain the direct current microgrid that is the subject of this pilot.

- 4. The information constitutes "information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of Tampa Electric to contract for similar services on favorable terms in the future." This file is also confidential because it contains "information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair" the competitive business of BlockEnergy. This information is thus "proprietary confidential business information" as set out in Section 366.093(2)(d)-(e) of the Florida Statutes. Tampa Electric continues to treat this information as confidential and has not disclosed it publicly. Furthermore, nothing has changed since the issuance of Order No. PSC-2023-0378-CFO-EI that would render the information stale or public such that confidential treatment would no longer be appropriate.
- 5. Tampa Electric respectfully requests that the Commission find that the information continues to be "proprietary confidential business information" and asks that it be treated as such for an additional period of at least 18 months and should be returned to Tampa Electric as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests that the confidential information subject to the Request (DN 05185-2023) continue to be afforded confidential classification for the reasons set forth above.
