I'm writing to urge the commission to reject the staff recommendations to place any burden of the treatment plant upgrades on the current residents of Grenelefe and instead allow the utility owner, Scott House, to recoup the \$20 million in upgrades from the new developers and new construction in Grenelefe through new connection fees.
