The Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) staff is recommending a rate hike that would raise our water & sewer bills more than $5 \times —$ from under \$50/month to over \$530/month.

This hike isn't just about "covering costs." Polk County already approved a fair plan where new development would pay for \$20 million in upgrades through CDD assessments and connection fees. But PSC staff rejected that and instead want existing residents like us to foot most of the bill.

What this means for us:

- Bills higher than almost anywhere in the country
- Property values at risk who will buy here with \$500+ utility bills?
- Double-charging homeowners who already paid for capacity once in their home purchase

The PSC will hold a virtual customer meeting on Sept 15 at 2:00 PM. We need as many Grenelefe residents as possible to show up (virtually) and speak out.

Action Steps:

⚠ If we don't push back, these extreme rates could become permanent. Let's stand together and demand that growth pays for growth — not current residents.

This will chase out 70 percent of occupants here and make them homeless, as many retirees are here on fixed income. It will also take the home value actually into the negative, we cannot give them away with a 5-600 dollar water bill..thats higher than a mortgage..literally the water bill is more than a 30 yr note.....I spoke with SEVERAL realtors, and as you can easily guess........Yes, real estate can go to ZERO. Ive owned this condo less than a week, did due diligence, title review, estoppel, etc, and just found out yesterday this is PENDING. A gov agency is making a private company charge existing homeowners 20 million dollars so the owner can build more houses............Say that and think its legal? Also, the owner of the Grenelefe property actually TRIED to pay 20 million, the ENITRE bill, and PSC said NO?????? Please look into this. I am NOT a legal expert, but kinda close. Doesn't pass ANY sniff testing at all. I can assure you I will not pay 5-600 for water, esp as I still work abroad. Please take a gander at this, and assist.
