Dear Commissioner:

I am writing to express my outrage of the proposed water rate increase by Sunlake Estates Utilities, LLC. This increase is astronomical:78% up to 190%. This is excessive. Sunlake demands we water our lawns 2 times per week, and we also have to pressure wash our house once a year, all this with 54 water breaks since I've lived there starting January, 2023. The invoice for our water has no contact information to complain to Sun.

Sunlake is trying to say there are 2.48 people per household. I don't know anybody with 3 people living in their houses. I want to know where they came up with that figure. I don't know of anybody that has more than 2 people living in a house and far too many are single residents who's spouses have passed away. In our 55+ community we are on fixed incomes. They raised our lot rent %5 this year with a projected 7% next year. I

have my house on the market right now. I can't afford to stay here. There are, as of last week, 27 homes for sale.

Please don't let this increase go through. I understand that increases are inevitable but 78% is way to excessive.

I will be listening on May 15th to hear the response to my concerns.
