The purpose of this filing is to implement the Basic Service monthly Storm Cost Recovery Charge in accordance with the Florida Public Service Commission's vote on September 20 to authorize an \$.85 monthly charge, in Docket No. 050374-TL. The charge will be assessed to each Basic Access Line or Facility beginning October 6, 2005, through October 5, 2007. In addition, this filing will also implement a Non-Basic Storm Cost Recovery Charge effective with the same effective date as the Basic Service date. These charges are being implemented to recover a portion of the extraordinary expenditures incurred by the Company for storm damage restoration related to Hurricanes Charley, Frances, Jeanne and Ivan during 2004. This surcharge will not be assessed to Lifeline customers.
