Add Safety Line Bundle**

Dear Ms Salak,

The purpose of this letter is to advise the commission that Quincy Telephone will be offering a mixed bundle called Safety Line Service. Safety Line is an optional bundle for residential customers who have their main telephone service with a wireless provider but, require a landline for emergency back-up and high speed data. The bundle includes a Residential One-Party line and 1.5 MBPS of high speed data at a monthly rate of \$39.95. Other data speeds may be available for an additional charge.

Safety Line Service will be provisioned where facilities are available. No other optional services or features are allowed with this bundle, except Toll Restriction, Toll Restriction PIN Override, Non-Published Numbers, and Non-Listed Numbers. These four services will be allowed at the rate listed elsewhere in the tariff.

Customers must subscribe to TDS Long distance Corporation as their long distance provider and will be billed at TDS Long Distance toll rates. Service Connection Charges will not apply. Seasonal Service and Optional Call Plans are not available with this bundle offering.
