ORDER DECLARING UNPAID PENALTIES UNCOLLECTABLE

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 20020, issued September 19, 1988, this Commission fined United Telesystems, Inc. d/b/a Multicall, Inc. (Multicall) \$2,000 for its violation of Rule 25-24.480, Florida Administrative Code. Also, Multicall owes outstanding Regulatory Assessment Fees of \$50.

The Commission has received two letters from Multicall's former attorney indicating that the company has not been operational for over two years and has no intention of providing interexchange services in the future.

Multicall cannot be located and it has failed to respond to any Commission correspondence. The Commission has exercised reasonable efforts to communicate with Multicall and collect the outstanding fine. Therefore, we find it appropriate to declare the \$2,000 fine assessed against Multicall as well as the \$50 outstanding Regulatory Assessment Fees uncollectable.

Based on the foregoing, it is therefore

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the fine of \$2,000 and the \$50 Regulatory Assessment Fees due by United Telesystems, Inc. d/b/a Multicall, Inc. are now determined to be uncollectable. It is further

ORDERED that this account be referred to the Department of Banking and Finance for further collection efforts or for permission to write off this fine as uncollectable.
