ORDER REGARDING CONFIDENTIALITY OF PORTIONS OF DN-1882-89

Florida Power Corporation (FPC) requests specified confidential classification of its responses to Numbers 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 of Occidental Chemical Corporation's (OCC) First Set of Interrogatories, identified as DN-1882-89.

FPC argues that the highlighted portions of the interrogatories and responses contain highly sensitive information regarding the rates charged to FPC's fuel supply affiliates for coal transportation. Disclosure of these rates, FPC argues, would impair the ability of its coal supplier, Electric Fuels Corporation (EFC), on behalf of FPC, to contract for such services on the most favorable terms.

Section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes, defines proprietary confidential business information to include:

Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.

An examination of the highlighted portions of DN-1882-89 indicates disclosure of such information could impair the ability of EFC to contract for such goods in the future and, therefore, the highlighted portions of DN-1882 are entitled to confidential classification.

FPC proposes neither a declassification date nor a reason it is unable to provide one.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that Florida Power Corporation's request for confidential classification of the highlighted portions of DN-1882-89 is granted. It is further

ORDERED that the material shall be declassified 18 months from the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that if a protest is filed within 14 days of the date of this Order, it shall be ruled upon by the appropriate Commission panel.
