Companies affected by the rule will be required to report the same information as they previously did, however, they will now be required to report it on a form supplied by the Commission. SUMMARY: The Commission proposes to change Rule 25-24.520, F.A.C., to adopt a form for pay telephone companies to use when submitting

information that is presently required by the rule to be reported each year.

25-24.520 Reporting Requirements.

(1) Each pay telephone service company shall file with the Commission's Division of Communications updated information for the following items within ten (10) days after <u>a</u> such change changes <u>occurs</u> occurs:

(a) The <u>street</u> address of the certificate holder <u>including</u> (street number, and <u>street</u> name, city, state and zip code, and <u>the</u>). If mailing address <u>if it</u> differs from <u>the street address</u> above, provide that also.

(b) Name, title, and phone number of <u>the</u> individual responsible for <u>contact with the</u> Commission contacts.

(2) Each pay telephone service company shall file <u>Commission</u> <u>Form PSC/CMU 39 (/)</u> with the Division of Communications by January 31 of each year.₇ <u>Form PSC/CMU 39</u>, entitled "Annual Pay <u>Telephone Service Report</u>, " is incorporated by reference into this <u>rule and may be obtained from the Commission's Division of</u> <u>Communications.</u> a report showing the certificate holder's name and address, the telephone number of the person responsible for <u>Commission contacts</u>, the number of instruments in place as of the end of the year, a statement of whether the company is currently providing service to customers and, if not, the last date service was provided to customers and plans for providing service in the ORDER NO.: 23715 DOCKET NO. 900762-TC PAGE 4

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(3) Each pay telephone service company shall by January 31 of each year provide a report to the local exchange companies listing the station number and location of all of its pay telephones. Specific Authority: 350.127(2), F. S.
