ORDER GRANTING FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR 180-DAY EXTENSION OF SOLAR INCENTIVE DISCONTINUANCE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 2, 1990 this Commission issued Order No. 23560 proposing to approve Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL) conservation plan subject to certain conditions. As part of the approved plan FPL proposed to modify its Conservation Water Heating Program by excluding incentives for the installation of solar water heating equipment. On October 23, 1990 FPL, after consulting with solar industry representatives, petitioned the Commission for a 180-day extension to continue its solar incentive option. During 180 days FPL stated it intends to review it previous finding that the solar inventive option lacked cost effectiveness.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission the request of Florida Power & Light Company to extend by 180 days the implementation of the elimination of the solar incentive option in its Conservation Water Heating Program is granted. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 23560 in all other respects is considered a final order and Docket No. 900091-EG is closed.
