ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE OBJECTIONS

By motion dated May 3, 1996, Palm Coast Utility Corporation (PCUC) filed its Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Objections and Notice of Intent to File Motion for Protective Order, pursuant to Rule 25-22.037(2), Florida Administrative Code. The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) filed no response to the motion. On May 13, 1996 PCUC filed its Certificate of Service of Responses to Citizens' 2nd Set of Interrogatories and Responses to Citizens' 2nd Set of Requests for Production of Documents. PCUC's responses contained objections to certain of OPC's 2nd sets of discovery requests.

Order No. PSC-96-0577-PCO-WS, issued May 2, 1996, requires in part that:

When discovery requests are served and the respondent intends to object to or ask for clarification of the discovery request, the objection or request for clarification shall be made within ten days of service of the discovery request. This procedure is intended to reduce delay in resolving discovery disputes.

PCUC states that it was served the Citizens' Second Set of Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents on April 12, 1996. PCUC, through its motion, requests that it be granted an extension of time until May 13, 1996, in which to file its objections to OPC's second sets of discovery.

Based upon a review of PCUC's motion, PCUC's request for an extension of time is hereby granted. PCUC's objections to OPC's second sets of discovery filed on May 13, 1996 are hereby deemed timely filed.

Based on the foregoing, it is .



NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
