AMENDATORY ORDER

On September 9, 1996, we issued Order No. PSC-96-1136-FOF-TL (Order) in these dockets. The Order inadvertently stated in several places on pages 2 and 3 that GTE Florida Incorporated and United Telephone Company of Florida had switch limitations that would allow a customer to access an interexchange carrier by 10XXX dialing to carry certain extended calling service (ECS) calls. The Order should have stated that the only switch limitation for GTEFL and United on these ECS routes is 1+ dialing.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-96-1136-FOF-TL is amended as discussed above. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-96-1136-FOF-TL is affirmed in all other respects.


