ORDER REQUIRING NOTICE TO REUSE WATER CUSTOMERS

This matter has been scheduled for a formal hearing on February 6 and 7, 1997, in Lee County, Florida. While Gulf Utility Company (Gulf) has not requested a rate for its reuse customers, the Commission's decision in this proceeding may affect reuse water customers in this proceeding. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 25-22.0407(5), Florida Administrative Code, Gulf shall provide notice of these proceedings to all current reuse water customers. Gulf shall provide written notice within seven days of the issuance date of this order to all current reuse water customers that a charge may be imposed as a result of this proceeding for furnishing reuse water. The notice shall be approved by Commission staff prior to distribution. The notice shall be mailed to the out-of-town address of all customers who have provided the utility with an out-of-town address.

Based upon the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Commissioner J. Terry Deason, as Prehearing Officer, that Gulf Utility Company shall provide notice in accordance with Rule 25-22.0407(5), Florida Administrative Code, to all current reuse water customers within seven days of the issuance date of this order as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that the notice shall be approved by the Commission staff prior to distribution. The notice shall be mailed to the out-of-town address of all customers who have provided the utility with an out-of-town address.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
