ORDER SUSPENDING PROPOSED MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGE TAXEE

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Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc., (Cinnamon Ridge or utility) is a Class C water-only utility which serves approximately 204 water customers in Citrus County, Florida. According to its 1996 Annual Report, the utility's operating revenue is \$38,495. The utility serves an area that has not been designated by the Southwest Florida Water Management District as a water use caution area. The utility's last rate case increase of 14.90%, was granted pursuant to Order No. FSC-95-0198-FOF-WO, issued February 9, 1995.

On November 7, 1997, the utility filed an application to increase its miscellaneous service charges. Pursuant to Section 367.091(c), Florida Statutes, the tariff sheets proposed by the utility shall become effective within sixty days after filing, unless the commission votes to withhold consent implementation of the request. Further, pursuant to Section 367.091(5), an application to establish, increase, or change a rate or charge other than the monthly rates of service available to customers for a class justifies

We have reviewed the utility's application and the proposed transmission line. Considering we believe it is reasonable and

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necessary to require further application, explanation and corroboration of the utility's application to increase its miscellaneous service charges. We, therefore, find it appropriate to suspend the proposed miscellaneous service charges.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ordered by the Florida Public Service Commission that the proposed tariff to increase its miscellaneous service charges filed by Cinnamom Ridge Utilities, Inc., is hereby suspended in accordance with Section 367, Utility, Florida Statutes. It is further

ordered that this docket shall remain open.

This notice publicizes information required by Section 367, Utility, Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any proposed increase in rates and services and to advise them of their rights under this notice. This notice will be forwarded to each individual requesting for an administrative hearing and will be given full consideration in the relief

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Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: 1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a prehearing Officer; 2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or 3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary procedure, or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
