ORDER SUSPENDING PROPOSED MISCELLANEOUS
SERVICE CHARGE TARIFF

BY THE COMMISSION:

Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc. (Cinnamon Ridge or utility) is a Class C water-only utility which serves approximately 204 water customers in Citrus County, Florida. According to its 1996 Annual Report, the utility's operating revenue is \$38,495. The utility serves an area that has not been designated by the Southwest Florida Water Management District as a water use caution area. The utility's last rate case increase of 14.99%, was granted pursuant to Order No. PSC-95-0188-POF-W0, issued February 9, 1995.

On November 7, 1997, the utility filed an application to increase its miscellaneous service charges. Pursuant to Section 367.091(5), Florida Statutes, the tariff sheets proposed by the utility shall become effective within sixty days after filing, unless the Commission votes to withhold consent implementation of the request. Further, pursuant to Section 367.091(5), an application to establish, increase, or change a rate or charge other than the monthly rates or service availability charges must be accompanied by a cost justification.

We have reviewed the utility's application and the proposed charges. Upon consideration, we believe it is reasonable and


necessary to require further amplification, explanation and corroboration of the utility's application to increase its miscellaneous service charges. We, therefore, find it appropriate to suspend the proposed miscellaneous service charges.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the proposed tariff to increase its miscellaneous service charges filed by Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc., is hereby suspended in accordance with Section 367.091(5), Florida Statutes. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall remain open.

NOTICE OF FURTHER APPEALANCE OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 360.04(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any appeal filed for hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that it establishes under Section 360.57 of 190.06, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: 1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.038(2), Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; 2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or 3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
