ORDER AUTHORIZING APPEARANCE  
AS QUALIFIED REPRESENTATIVES

In this order we grant a request made under Rule 28-106.107, Florida Administrative Code, that Andrew M. Klein and Allen C. Zoracki be designated as qualified representatives, authorized to represent before this Commission the interests of BullsEye Telecom, Inc. (BullsEye), even though they are not admitted to practice law in Florida. In its Petition, BullsEye requested that Andrew M. Klein and Allen C. Zoracki be designated as its qualified representatives in Docket No. 090538-TP only, with such representation continuing for the duration of such docket.

In designating Andrew M. Klein and Allen C. Zoracki as qualified representatives, we have confirmed that the application conforms to the requirements of the rule and that, based on the information contained in the application, Andrew M. Klein and Allen C. Zoracki have the necessary qualifications to represent the interests of BullsEye, as contemplated under the rule. For example, Andrew M. Klein and Allen C. Zoracki are admitted to practice law in states other than Florida.

The qualified representatives designation is reflected in the Appendix, which is incorporated as part of the body of this order.

ORDERED by Chairman Art Graham, as Presiding Officer, that the persons identified in the Appendix to this order, Andrew M. Klein and Allen C. Zoracki, are hereby authorized to appear as Qualified Representatives for BullsEye Telecom, Inc.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk, and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
