Enders, on behalf of Tyndall and Eglin Air Force Bases, Hurlburt Field, Pensacola Naval Air Station, Whiting Naval Air Station, and the Naval Coastal Systems Center in Panama City, Florida, have substantial interests in Gulf Power Company's (Gulf's) 15 December 1989 application for an increase in its rates charges. 


