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FLORIDA MUNICIPAL POWER AGENCY'S PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE

The FLORIDA MUNICIPAL POWER AGENCY ("FMPA"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, F.A.C., and Sections 366.076(1), 366.05(8) and 366.055, Florida Statutes, hereby files this Petition for Leave to Intervene (the "Petition to Intervene") in the above-captioned proceedings. In support of this Petition to Intervene, FMPA states as follows:

1. FMPA is a generation and transmission utility supplying electric capacity and energy to certain of its members in Florida ACK Power & Light Company's ("FPL") service area through its own AFA generation resources and through the purchase of power and CAF transmission services from other utilities, including FPL. - 4. FMPA desires to intervene and become a party participant in the above-captioned proceeding and as grounds therefor states that as a wholesale power and transmission customer of FPL, the petitioner in the above-styled docket, FMPA is entitled to participate by law, and its substantial interests are subject to determination or will be affected through this proceeding. Particularly, the effect that this proceeding will have on FPL's ability to supply FMPA with its wholesale power and transmission needs.
- 5. FMPA is a wholesale power and transmission customer of FPL and as such is dependent upon FPL having an adequate source of generation and transmission facilities in order for FPL to meet its contractual obligations to FMPA. Without an adequate source of wholesale power and transmission facilities, FMPA and the municipalities that FMPA supplies will experience serious economic consequences as well as public health and safety problems.
- 6. FPL states in paragraph 2 of its Petition that "absent the installation or acquisition of sufficient additional generating capacity, FPL will not be able to continue to meet its 1996 forecast peak load and maintain adequate levels of reliability." As a wholesale customer of FPL, FMPA is or will be substantially affected by any supply interruptions, any significant fuel price increases, and/or reliability problems experienced by FPL.
- During the infamous Christmas freeze of 1989, FMPA's wholesale purchases from FPL were substantially curtailed by FPL

due to significant (and unprecedented) capacity shortages experienced by FPL. As a result, FMPA is or will be substantially affected by these proceedings. FPL has determined that this facility is needed to serve its load (customers) which load (customers) includes FMPA.

8. FPL has stated in paragraph 5 of the Petition that:

In addition, Southern Companies has agreed to use its best efforts to negotiate agreements with peninsular Florida Utilities for the construction of additional transmission facilities so as to provide an additional 500mw of Southern/Florida interface capability to FPL. FPL's purchase of any ownership interest in Scherer is contingent upon obtaining definitive agreements for all aspects of transmission capability necessary to transmit FPL's share of the unit output to FPL's service area.

FMPA as a wholesale power and transmission customer of FPL and as a peninsular Florida utility has a substantial interest in these proceedings and the attendant transactions.

9. FMPA is unaware at this time of any disputed issues of material fact.

WHEREFORE, FMPA requests oral argument on its Amended Petition for Leave to Intervene and that it be granted leave to intervene in this proceeding.
