BACKGROUND

The Woods, a division of Homasassa Utilities, Inc., is a Class C utility. It provides service to approximately 60 customers. The utility recorded test year revenues of \$6,973 and \$6,038 for water and wastewater, respectively. Its recorded operating expenses are \$14,225 and \$12,205 for water and wastewater, respectively, resulting in a net operating loss of \$7,252, and \$6,167 for water and wastewater, respectively.

The test period for setting rates in the historical average twelve month period ended December 31, 1990.

CURRENT AND PRELIMINARY RATES AND CHARGES

Staff has compiled the following rates and charges for the purpose of discussion at the customer meeting. These rates are preliminary and subject to change based on information gathered at the customer meeting, further Staff review, and the final decision by the Commissioners.
