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Issue 3: Recommendation that the Commission fine MTS-Tampa and Sunforest Communications Group \$1,000 each for violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480 which requires IXCs to file annual reports with the Commission by January 31 of each year. If MTS-Tampa and Sunforest do not pay the \$1,000 fine within 20 days of issuance of the order, their certificates should be cancelled and the docket closed.

APPROVED

Issue 4: Recommendation that the Commission fine Communications Catalyst Corporation \$1,000 for violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480 which requires IXCs to file annual reports with the Commission by January 31 of each year. If Communications Catalyst does not pay the fine within 20 days of issuance of the order, staff recommends that the Commission cancel Communications Catalyst's Certificate No. 2448.

Issue 5: Recommendation that the Commission fine Excel Telecommunications, Inc. \$1,000 for violation of Commission Rule 25-24.480, which requires IXCs to file annual reports with the Commission by January 31, of each year. If Excel does not pay the \$1,000 fine within 20 days of issuance of the order, Excel's certificate should be cancelled and the docket closed.

Issue 6: Recommendation that these dockets be held open pending payment of the fines. Staff also recommends that if the fine is paid within 20 days of issuance of the final order, the docket should be closed administratively. Staff further recommends that if the fine is not paid within 20 days of issuance of the final order, then the IXC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be cancelled, the imposed fine should be waived and the docket should be closed.
