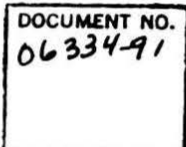

COMMISSIONER WILSON: We'll call the hearing to order. Read the notice, please.

MR. ELIAS: Notice of Hearing filed by the Clerk's Office on May 17th, 1991, advises that a Prehearing Conference will be held in this docket at the following time and place: 9:30 a.m., June 24th, 1991, Room 106 of the Fletcher Building, 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida.

COMMISSIONER WILSON: We will take appearances of Counsel.

MS. STUART: Cheryl Stuart, of the law firm Hopping Boyd Green and Sams, P.O. Box 6526, Tallahassee, Florida 32314, on behalf of Florida Power Corporation.

With me today is Carolyn Raepple, R-a-e-p-p-l-e, of the same law firm, and also Pamela Smith of Florida Power Corporation, P.O. Box 14042, St. Petersburg, Florida 33733.

8 this stuff.

12 MS. STUART: The only other procedural item
13 is that we have some additional large exhibits that we
14 are going to use at the hearing. We can add them to
15 the Prehearing Order now or we can do it at hearing.

16 COMMISSIONER WILSON: Right. That was
17 mentioned in the Prehearing Order.

18 MS. STUART: Correct, that we will have some.
19 If you want to identify them now, we can do that, or we
20 can do it later.

21 COMMISSIONER WILSON: Well, why don't you
22 just give them to Staff to put in the final version of
23 the Prehearing Order, and then we will have it and we
24 will be ready to go.

25 Anything else?

1 MR. ELIAS: One other thing. The exhibits
2 that are on Page --

3 COMMISSIONER WILSON: Don't take too much
4 time, we are going for a record.

5 MS. STUART: We are going for the record.

6 MR. ELIAS: -- 3 of the Prehearing Order will
7 be labeled as Exhibits 1 through 5 in the order that
8 they are listed in the Prehearing Order.

9 COMMISSIONER WILSON: All right. Anything
10 further?

11 MR. ELIAS: Nothing.

12 COMMISSIONER WILSON: If not, we are
13 adjourned. Thank you very much.

14 MS. STUART: Thank you, sir.
