SOUTHERN STATES UTILITIES, INC. ("SSU") and DELTONA UTILITIES, INC. ("DUI"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Applicant", pursuant to Rule 25-30.436, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files it Application for authority to increase water and wastewater rates and charges and states as follows:



- 3. Applicant SSU was incorporated on November 22, 1961 under the laws of the State of Florida and is currently authorized to conduct business in the State of Florida. Applicant DUI was incorporated on August 14, 1978 under the laws of the State of Florida and is currently authorized to conduct business in the State of Florida. Applicants are wholly-owned subsidiaries of Topeka Group, Inc. ("Topeka"). Topeka Group, Inc.'s address is 30 West Superior Street, Duluth, Minnesota 55802.
- 4. This Application is filed pursuant to Chapter 367, Florida Statutes (1991), and, in particular, Sections 367.081 and 367.082, Florida Statutes (1991).
- 5. Applicant requests that this Application be scheduled for formal hearing and not processed pursuant to the Proposed Agency Action procedure outlined in Section 367.081(8), Florida Statutes (1991).
- 6. An affidavit signed by Forrest L. Ludsen, Vice President of Customer Services of the Applicant, stating that Applicant will comply with Rule 25-22.0406, Florida Administrative Code, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 7. Applicant does not know of any manner in which this Application deviates from the policies, procedures or guidelines prescribed by the Commission in relevant rules or prescribed by the Commission in Applicant's last rate case.

- 8. A check dated May 11, 1992 in the amount of \$9,000.00 accompanies this Application as the filing fee.
- 9. Applicant provides water and wastewater service through 127 systems in 19 counties pursuant to certificates issued by the Commission.
- 10. The names of the 127 systems, the county in which each system is located, the certificates of authority pursuant to which each system is operated and the number of the Commission's last order which previously considered Applicant's rates for the systems included in this Application are identified in Exhibit "B".
- 11. The documents containing the minimum filing requirements in support of and accompanying this Application are listed in Exhibit "C".
- 12. This Application and supporting documents may be inspected at the locations listed in Exhibit "D".
- 13. The necessity for a rate increase arises from the fact that Applicant did not earn a fair and reasonable rate of return for the test year ended December 31, 1991. Based on known changes to the historical test year ended December 31, 1991:
- (a) The Applicant experienced a combined rate of return of only 2.54% on a combined rate base of \$57,138,260 for the 127 water and wastewater systems included in this Application. This rate of return is equivalent to an overall return on common equity of -8.32%.
- (b) For the 90 water systems filed in this Application, Applicant experienced a rate of return of only 3.07% and a return

on common equity of -7.07% on a consolidated rate base of \$34,238,883.

(c) For the 37 wastewater systems filed in this Application, Applicant experienced a rate of return of only 1.74% and a return on common equity of -10.18% on a consolidated rate base of \$22,899,377.

The consolidated rates of return and rate bases for the water and wastewater systems for the test year ended December 31, 1991 are identified in Exhibit "E". The rates of return and rate bases of each water and wastewater system for the test year ended December 31, 1991 are identified in Exhibit "F".

- 14. The Applicant proposes and will establish in this proceeding that a fair and reasonable rate of return on its combined water and wastewater rate base is 11.57%, as set forth in Exhibit "E".
- 15. In order to have an opportunity to earn a fair and reasonable rate of return on the rate base for each water and wastewater system, the Commission should allow Applicant to place into effect final rates which will produce additional sales revenues for its combined water and wastewater operations of \$8,673,135. This increase results in total combined water and wastewater revenues of \$28,878,505. The Applicant is proposing sales revenue increases for water operations of \$5,071,970 and for wastewater operations of \$3,601,165. These increases result in consolidated water revenues of \$18,006,393 and consolidated wastewater revenues of \$10,872,112, as reflected in Exhibit "E".

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The proposed sales revenue increases to the water and wastewater systems included in this Application and the proposed total revenues from sales for each of such systems are identified in Exhibit "G".

- 16. Pending the establishment of permanent rates in this proceeding, Applicant requests interim water and wastewater rates which are set forth in Volume I, Book 1 of 4 of Applicant's minimum filing requirements. These interim rates are based on the test year ended December 31, 1991 and will produce additional sales revenues for Applicant's combined water and wastewater operations in the amount of \$6,982,740. The proposed revenue increases for consolidated water operations is \$3,988,916 and for consolidated wastewater operations is \$2,993,824, respectively. These increases result in total combined revenues for water and wastewater operations on an interim basis of \$27,081,389, as identified in Exhibit "E". In addition, the operating revenues produced by the proposed interim rates for each water and wastewater system are set forth in Exhibit "H".
- 17. The rate relief requested in this Application is critical to the Applicant's ability to meet capital funding requirements to serve its customers. Due to the lack of needed rate relief and existing construction requirements, the Applicant has experienced a combined coverage ratio of pre-tax income to fixed charges (utilizing Standard & Poor's methodology) of 0.76% for audited 1990 operations and 0.36% for 1991 operations, followed by 0.39% for the first fiscal quarter ending March 31, 1992. An interest coverage

ratio below 1.5 makes it difficult if not impossible to raise external capital at any cost. The effect of the foregoing coverage ratio has been to: (a) limit Applicant's negotiating flexibility on existing debt covenants, (b) expand restrictive covenants on existing obligation renewals, and (c) necessitate the use of short-term capital sources to fund long-term capital project requirements and the use of affiliate credit support. Interim rate relief is critical at this time to enable Applicant to raise needed capital at reasonable costs. Due to the current financial condition of the Applicant, it is extremely difficult to amend the existing indenture for the first mortgage bonds of DUI in order to legally consolidate the Applicant. Upon the granting of interim rates, Applicant hopefully will be in a position to complete financial restructuring and consolidation.

18. Applicant requests that the Commission approve the proposed allowance for funds used during construction ("AFUDC") and allowance for funds prudently invested ("AFPI") set forth in Schedule A of Volume I, Book 1 of 4 (AFUDC) and Schedule G of Volume I, Book 4 of 4 (AFPI), respectively, for each of those systems.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant requests:

- A. that the Commission take jurisdiction over this Application;
- B. that the Commission allow Applicant to place into effect on a permanent basis rates which will produce additional operating revenues for its combined water and wastewater operations in the

amount of \$8,673,135 as set forth in Exhibit "E"; and for each system as set forth in Exhibit "G" of this Application;

- C. that the Commission find that a fair and reasonable rate of return on Applicant's combined water and wastewater rate bases of \$57,138,260 is 11.57% based on the test year ended December 31, 1991 as set forth in **Exhibit "E"** of this Application;
- D. that the Commission allow Applicant to place into effect interim rates which will produce additional operating revenues for its combined water and wastewater operations in the amount of \$6,982,740, as set forth in Exhibit "E"; and for each system as set forth in Exhibit "H" of this Application;
- E. that the Commission approve the AFUDC and AFPI charges filed herewith; and
- F. that the Commission grant any other relief it deems fair, just, equitable and appropriate.
