We are in receipt of your letter dated June 5, 1992, concerning Item No. 3 of our May 29, 1992, deficiency letter. We are in partial agreement with your letter. We believe that you have provided a satisfactory tax calculation by system per the Schedule B-16's. You have not, however, provided a breakdown between water and wastewater as required on Schedule C-1, C-2, C-3 and C-5. Our letter of May 21, 1992, is hereby amended to remove the "per system basis" requirement as a deficiency of Item No. 3. The remaining deficiency of Item No. 3 must be completed.

What brought this to our attention is the fact that the Utility Adjusted column on Schedules C-1, C-2, C-3 and C-5 are apparently total company figures. They include all regulated and nonregulated systems. This makes it impossible to tie the B-16 Schedules to the "C" Schedules. Although technically not a deficiency, the Utility adjusted column should have included only those systems filed in this application. The systems not included in this application, both regulated and nonregulated, should be removed by an adjustment in the second column. Since this information is needed we will be requesting it through an
