

The area in question is in the heart of a low-density residential community, and the plant in question is intended to facilitate a highdensity development. Water supplies for the island are already at a critical level, particularly for fire fighting needs. We respectfully request that you deny this request because of the dangers cited above to the community, to the environment, and the health and safety of the public.
