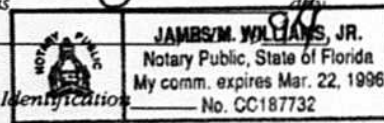

**PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE**

The purpose of this hearing will be to take evidence to determine the need, pursuant to Section 403.9422, Florida Statutes, for the construction and operation of the proposed intrastate natural gas pipeline lateral for the Sunshine Pipeline. The lateral, which would be called the "Hardee lateral", would originate from the Polk County terminus of the Sunshine mainline pipeline and extend into Hardee County. It will consist of 17.9 miles of 16 inch pipe to serve the Seminole Electric Cooperative Hardee Power Station Project located in Hardee County.

The need determination proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, Section 403.9422, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-22, Florida Administrative Code.

Under Section 403.9422, the Commission is the sole forum for the determination of need for the proposed Hardee lateral. In making its determination, the Commission must take into account the need for electric system reliability and integrity, the need for natural gas delivery reliability, safety, and integrity, the need for abundant, cleanburning natural gas at a reasonable cost, and other matters within its jurisdiction that it deems relevant.

The Commission determined that there is a need for the Sunshine mainline pipeline in Docket No. 920807-GP, Order No. PSC 93-0987-FOF-GP, issued July 2, 1993. Only issues relating to the need for the proposed Hardee lateral will be heard at the May 27, 1994 hearing. Separate public hearings will be held before the Division of Administrative Hearings and the Governor and Cabinet sitting as the Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline Siting Board to consider other matters required to be determined under the Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline Siting Act, Sections 403.9401-403.9425, Florida Statutes.
