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

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3. Sprint is an interexchange carrier ("IXC") duly certificated by the Commission to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Florida. As a certificated IXC, Sprint is subject to the rules, regulations, and orders of the Commission, and such rules, regulations, and orders impact Sprint's ability to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service.

4. The above-referenced docket was opened for the purpose of resolving petition(s) to establish nondiscriminatory rates, terms, and conditions for interconnection involving local exchange companies ("LECs") and alternative local exchange companies ("ALECs") pursuant to recent revisions to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. As an IXC, Sprint must use the local network facilities of LECs and will potentially use the local network facilities of ALECs to reach its customers. The issues in this docket could impact, either directly or indirectly, those services and Sprint's ability to deliver interexchange services to its customers. Consequently, Sprint's substantial interests will be affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

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
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
