Your letter dated January 22, 1996, has been referred to me for a response. The Commission's order in Docket No. 920199-WS granting increased rates for Southern States Utilities, Inc. (SSU) based on a uniform rate structure was appealed by Citrus County and Sugarmill Woods Civic Association. On April 6, 1995, the Commission's decision was reversed and remanded by the First District Court of Appeal. The Commission did request a rehearing, but the Commission's Motion for Rehearing was denied by the Court. A mandate was issued by the Court on July 13, 1995. The Commission also filed a joinder of SSU's petition seeking review by the Supreme Court. That request was also denied.

In complying with the Court's mandate, the Commission issued its order in October approving a different rate structure for SSU. In doing that, the Commission had to choose a rate structure supported by the evidence presented in Docket No. 920199-WS that was consistent with the Court's opinion. The Commission chose a modified stand alone rate

structure. On a going-forward basis, the new rate structure may result in higher rates for some of SSU's customers. SSU has sought reconsideration of that decision. That matter is pending before the Commission in Docket No. 920199-WS.

In the most recent rate case, Docket No. 950495-WS, the utility has requested approval of its proposal to implement the uniform rate structure. As you know, this decision is pending before the Commission. I hope this letter responds to your concerns. Your letter will be placed in the docket's correspondence file.
