

Dear Sir or Madam:

This is in response to Christine Tomlinson's letter of February 8, 1996. Each item addressed in the letter has been corrected.

With respect to the initial connection fee that was specified on Original Sheet No. 15.0, that charge has been eliminated to zero (0) in this amended filing. I have spoken with the Manatee County Utility Department and have confirmed that the County will be collecting the connection fee directly from any new customers instead of it being collected by Sunny Shores Water Company, Inc. and passed on to the County. This change carries over to Sheet No. 16.0 in the line for Customer Connection (Tap-In Charge).

With respect to the \$250.00 charge that was previously shown for Meter Installation, we have revised that figure to reflect the Utility's actual costs. The charge that the Utility seeks approval for is now \$115.00, derived as follows:

* Materials:

(Meter \$30.00, Couplings \$5.00, Meter Box & Lid \$15.00, Hose Bib \$5.00, Backflow Vacuum Breaker \$5.00, Miscellaneous Pipes & Fittings \$5.00).

The Meter Installation Fee is based strictly on costs, with no mark-up. The actual cost varies to some extent due to changes in outside labor and materials costs, but since this franchise area is for all practical purposes built-out, this item does not represent a significant source of revenue for the Utility. If the preferred practice is to show this line item as "Actual Cost", the Utility certainly has no objection to using that approach. On the other hand, if the preferred practice is to specify an amount, the Utility is willing to set this fee as indicated above since costs have not changed significantly in the last few years. I have included two versions of Sheet No. 16.0 and your staff may feel free to adopt either one it prefers. We simply need to be advised as to which one is selected.

I appreciate your assistance in this matter. If there is anything further that you need, please let me know.



TECHNICAL TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS

- 1.0 <u>*BFC*</u> *BFC* is the abbreviation for *Base Facility Charge* which is the minimum amount the utility may charge to the Company's customers and is separate from the amount billed for wastewater consumption on the utility's bills to its customers.
- 2.0 <u>*CERTIFICATE*</u> A document issued by the Commission authorizing the Company to provide wastewater service in a specific territory.
- 3.0 'COMMISSION' 'Commission' refers to the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 4.0 <u>'COMMUNITIES SERVED'</u> The group of customers who receive wastewater service from the Company and who's service location is within a specific area or locality that is uniquely separate from another.
- 5.0 'COMPANY' Sunny Shores Water Co., Inc.
- 6.0 <u>*CUSTOMER*</u> Any person, firm or corporation who has entered into an agreement to receive wastewater service from the Company and who is liable for the payment of that wastewater service.
- 7.0 <u>*CUSTOM*</u> <u>'SINSTALLATION*</u> All pipes, shut-offs, valves, fixtures and appliances or apparatus of every kind and nature which are located on the customer's side of the *Point of Collection* and used in connection with or forming a part of the installation necessary for disposing of sewage collected from the customer's premises regardless of whether such installation is owned by the customer or used by the customer under lease or other agreement.
- 8.0 <u>*MAIN*</u> A pipe, conduit, or facility used for conveying wastewater service through individual services or through other mains.
- 9.0 <u>*POINT OF COLLECTION*</u> For wastewater systems, *point of collection* shall mean point at which the Company's piping, fittings, and valves connection with the customer's piping, fittings and valves.
- 10.0 <u>'RATE'</u> Amount which the utility may charge for wastewater service which is applied to the customer's water consumption.
- 11.0 <u>*PATE SCHEDULE*</u> The rate(s) or charge(s) for a particular classification of service plus the several provisions necessary for billing, including all special terms and conditions under which service shall be furnished at such rate or charge.

Service shall conform to the standards set forth in Section 367,111 of the Florida Statutes.
- 13.0 <u>*SERVICE LINES*</u> The pipe between the Company's mains and the point of delivery and shall include all of the pipe, fittings and valves necessary to make the connection to the customer's premises excluding the meter.
- 14.0 <u>*TERRITORY*</u> The geographical area described by metes and bounds with township, range and section in a certificate, which may be within or without the boundaries of an incorporated municipality and, may include areas in more than one county.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION - These Rules and Regulations are a part of the rate schedules and applications and contracts of the Company and, in the absence of specific written agreement to the contrary, apply without modifications or change to each and every customer to whom the Company renders wastewater service.

The Company shall provide wastewater service to all customers requiring such service within its certificated territory pursuant to Chapter 25-30, Florida Administrative Code and Chapter 367, Florida Statutes.

- 2.0 POLICY DISPUTE Any dispute between the Company and the customer or prospective customer regarding the meaning or application of any provision of this tariff shall upon written request by either party be resolved by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 3.0 <u>APPLICATION</u> In accordance with Rule 25-30.310, Florida Administrative Code, a signed application is required prior to the initiation of service.
- 4.0 <u>APPLICATIONS BY AGENTS</u> Applications for wastewater service requested by firms, partnerships, associations, corporations, and others shall be rendered only by duly authorized panies or agents.
- 5.0 <u>REFUSAL OR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE</u> The Company may refuse or discontinue wastewater service rendered under application made by any member or agent of a household, organization, or business in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 6.0 EXTENSIC* S- Extensions will be made to the Company's facilities in compliance with Commission Rules and Orders and the Company's fariff.
- 7.0 LIMITATION OF USE Wastewater service purchased from the Company shall be used by the customer only for the purposes specified in the application for wastewater service. Wastewater service shall be rendered to the customer for the customer's own use and shall be collected directly into the Company's main wastewater lines.

In no case shall a customer, except with the written consent of the company, extend his lines across a street, alley, lane, court, property line, avenue, or other way in order to furnish wastewater service to the adjacent property even though such adjacent property may be owned by him. In case of such unauthorized extension, sale, or disposition of service, the customer's wastewater service will be subject to discontinuance until such unauthorized extension, remetering, sale or disposition of service is discontinued and full payment is made to the Company for water service rendered by the Company (calculated on proper classification and rate schedules) and until reimbursement in full is made in full to the Company for all extra expenses incurred for clerical work, testing, and inspections.

8.0 CONTINUITY OF SERVICE - In accordance with Rule 25-30.250, Florida Administrative Code, the company will at all times use reasonable diligence to provide continuous wastewater service and, having used reasonable diligence, shall not be liable to the customer for failure or interruption of continuous wastewater service.

If at any time the Company shall interrupt or discontinue its service, all customers affected by said interruption or discontinuance shall be given not less than 24 hours written notice.

- 9.0 TYPE AND MAINTENANCE In accordance with Rule 25-30.545, Florida Administrative Code, the customer's pipes, apparatus and equipment shall be selected, installed, used and maintained in accordance with standard practice and shall conform with the Rules and Regulations of the Company and shall comply with all Laws and Governmental Regulations applicable to same. The Company shall not be responsible for the maintenance and operation of the customer's pipes and facilities. The customer expressly agrees not to utilize any appliance or device which is not properly constructed, controlled and protected or which may adversely affect the wastewater service; the Company reserves the right to discontinue or withhold wastewater service to such apparatus or device.
- 10.0 CHANGE OF CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION No changes or increases in the customer's installation, which will materially affect the proper operation of the pipes, mains, or stations of the Company, shall be made without written consent of the Company. The customer shall be liable for any change resulting from a violation of this Rule.
- 11.0 INSPECTION OF CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION All customer's wastewater service installations or changes shall be inspected upon completion by a competent authority to ensure that the customer's piping, equipment, and devices have been installed in accordance with accepted standard practice and local Laws and Governmental Regulations. Where Municipal or other Governmental inspection is required by local Rules and Ordinances, the Company cannot render wastewater service until such inspection has been made and a formal notice of approval from the inspecting authority has been received by the Company.

Not withstanding the above, the Company reserves the right to inspect the customer's installation prior to rendering wastewater service, and from time to time thereafter, but assumes no responsibility whatsoever for any portion thereof.

- 12.0 PROTECTION OF COMPANY'S PROPERTY The customer shall exercise reasonable diligence to protect the Company's property. If the customer is found to have tampered with any utility property or refuses to correct any problems reported by the utility, service may be discontinued in accordance with Rule 25-30.320. Florida Administrative Code. In the event of any loss or damage to property of the Company caused by or arising out of carelessness, neglect, or misuse by the customer, the cost of making good such loss or repairing such damage shall be paid by the customer.
- 13.0 <u>ACCESS TO PREMISES</u> In accordance with Rule 25-30.320(2)(f), Florida Administrative Code, the customer shall provide the duly authorized agents of the Company access at all reasonable hours to its property. If reasonable access is not provided, service may be discontinued pursuant to the above rule.
- 14.0 <u>RIGHT OF WAY OR EASEMENTS</u> The customer shall grant or cause to be granted to the Company, and without cost to the Company, all rights, easements, permits, and privileges which are necessary for the rendering of wastewater service.
- 15.0 <u>CUSTOMER BILLING</u> Bills for wastewater service will be rendered Monthly, Birnonthly, or Quarterly - as stated in the rate schedule.

In accordance with Rule 25-30.335, Florida Administrative Code, the utility may not consider a customer delinquent in paying his or her bill until the twenty-first day after the utility has mailed or presented the bill for payment.

A municipal or county franchise tax levied upon a water or wastewater public utility shall not be incorporated into the rate for water or wastewater service but shall be shown as a separate item on the utility's bills to its customers in such Municipality or County.

If a utility utilizes the base facility and usage charge rate structure and does not have a Commission authorized vacation rate, the utility shall bill the customer the base facility charge regardless of whether there is any usage.

- 16.0 <u>DELINQUENT BILLS</u> When it has been determined that a customer is delinquent in paying any bill, wastewater service may be discontinued after the Company has mailed or presented a written notice to the customer in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 17.0 PAYMENT OF WATERAND WASTEWATERSERVICE BILLS CONCURRENTLY- In accordance with Rule 25-30.320(2)(g), Florida Administrative Code, when both water and wastewater service are provided by the Company, payment of any wastewater service bill rendered by the Company to a customer shall not be accepted by the Company without the simultaneous or concurrent payment of any water service bill rendered by the Company.

- 19.0 <u>UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTIONS</u> <u>WASTEWATER</u> Any unauthorized connections to the customer's wastewater service shall be subject to immediate discontinuance without notice, in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 20.0 ADJUSTMENT OF BILLS When a customer has been undercharged as a result of incorrect application of the rate schedule, incorrect reading of the meter, incorrect connection of the meter, or other similar reasons, the amount may be billed to the customer as the case may be pursuant to Rules 25-30.340 and 25-30.350, Florida Administrative Code.
- 21.0 <u>FILING OF CONTRACTS</u> Whenever a Developer Agreement or Contract, Guaranteed Revenue Contract, or Special Contract of Agreement is entered into by the Company for the sale of its product or services in a manner not specifically covered by its Rules and Regulations or approved Rate Schedules, a copy of such contracts or agreements shall be filed with the Commission prior to its execution in accordance with Rule 25-9.034 and Rule 25-30.550, Florida Administrative Code. If such contracts or agreements are approved by the Commission, a conformed copy shall be placed on file with the Commission within 30 days of execution.
- 22.0 EVIDENCE OF CO*'GUMPTION The initiation or continuation or resumption of water service to the customer's premises shall constitute the initiation or continuation or resumption of wastewater service to the customer's premises regardless of occupancy.



RULES AND REGULATIONS +-

GENERAL INFORMATION - These Rules and Regulations are a part of the rate schedules and 1.0 applications and contracts of the Company and, in the absence of specific written agreement to the contrary, apply without modifications or change to each and every customer to whom the Company renders water service.

The Company shall provide water service to all customers requiring such service within its certificated territory pursuant to Chapter 25-30, Florida Administrative Code and Chapter 367, Florida Statutes.

- POLICY DISPUTE Any dispute between the Company and the customer or prospective customer 2.0 regarding the meaning or application of any provision of this tariff shall upon written request by either party be resolved by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- APPLICATION In accordance with Rule 25-30.310, Florida Administrative Code, a signed 3.0 application is required prior to the initiation of service.
- APPLICATIONS BY AGENTS Applications for water service requested by firms, partnerships, 4.0 associations, corporations, and others shall be rendered only by duly authorized parties or agents.
- REFUSAL OR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE The Company may refuse or discontinue water 5.0 service rendered under application made by any member or agent of a household, organization, or business in accu. dance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- EXTENSIONS Extensions will be made to the Company's facilities in compliance with Commission 6.0 Rules and Orders and the Company's tariff.
- LIMITATION OF USE Water service purchased from the Company shall be used by the customer 7.0 only for the purposes specified in the application for water service and the customer shall not sell or otherwise dispose of such water service supplied by the company.

In no case shall a customer, except with the written consent of the company, extend his lines across a street, alley, lane, court, property line, avenue, or other way in order to furnish water service to the adjacent property through one meter even though such adjacent property may be owned by him. In case of such unauthorized extension, sale, or disposition of service, the customer's water service will be subject to discontinuance until such unauthorized extension, remetering, sale or disposition of service is discontinued and full payment is made to the Company for water service rendered by the Company (calculated on proper classification and rate schedules) and until reimbursement in full is made in full to the Company for all extra expenses incurred for clerical work, testing, and inspections.

8.0 CONTINUITY OF SERVICE - In accordance with Rule 25-30.250, Florida Administrative Code, the company will at all times use reasonable diligence to provide continuous water service and, having used reasonable diligence, shall not be liable to the customer for failure or interruption of continuous water service.

If at any time the Company shall interrupt or discontinue its service, all customers affected by said interruption or discontinuance shall be given not less than 24 hours written notice.

- 9.0 TYPE AND MAINTENANCE In accordance with Rule 25-30.545, Florida Administrative Code, the customer's pipes, apparatus and equipment shall be selected, installed, used and maintained in accordance with standard practice and shall conform with the Rules and Regulations of the Company and shall comply with all Laws and Governmental Regulations applicable to same. The Company shall not be responsible for the maintenance and operation of the customer's pipes and fàcilities. The customer expressly agrees not to utilize any appliance or device which is not properly constructed, controlled and protected or which may adversely affect the water service; the Company reserves the right to discontinue or withhold water service to such apparatus or device.
- 10.0 CHANGE OF CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION No changes or increases in the customer's installation, which will materially affect the proper operation of the pipes, mains, or stations of the Company, shall be made without written consent of the Company. The customer shall be liable for any change resulting from a violation of this Rule.
- 11.0 INSPECTION OF CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION All customer's water service installations or changes shall be inspected upon completion by a competent authority to ensure that the customer's piping, equipment, and devices have been installed in accordance with accepted standard practice and local Laws and Governmental Regulations. Where Municipal or other Governmental inspection is required by local Rules and Ordinances, the Company cannot render water service until such inspection has been made and a formal notice of approval from the inspecting authority has been received by the Company.

Not withstanding the above, the Company reserves the right to inspect the customer's installation prior to rendering water service, and from time to time thereafter, but assumes no responsibility whatsoever for any portion thereof.

12.0 PROTECTION OF COMPANY'S PROPERTY - The customer shall exercise reasonable diligence to protect the Company's property. If the customer is found to have tampered with any utility property or refuses to correct any problems reported by the utility, service may be discontinued in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.

In the event of any loss or damage to property of the Company caused by or arising out of carelessness, neglect, or misuse by the customer, the cost of making good such loss or repairing such damage shall be paid by the customer.

- 13.0 ACCESSTO PREMISES In accordance with Rule 25-30.320(2) (f), Florida Administrative Code, the company shall provide the duly authorized agents of the Company access at all reasonable hours to its property. If reasonable access is not provided, service may be discontinued pursuant to the above rule.
- 14.0 RIGHT OF WAY OR EASEMENTS The customer shall grant or cause to be granted to the Company, and without cost to the Company, all rights, easements, permits, and privileges which are necessary for the rendering of water service.
- 15.0 CUSTOMER BILLING Bills for water service will be rendered Monthly, Bimonthly, or Quarterly as stated in the rate schedule.

In accordance with Rule 25-30.335, Florida Administrative Code, the utility may not consider a customer delinquent in paying his or her bill until the twenty-first day after the utility has mailed or presented the bill for payment.

A municipal or county franchise tax levied upon a water or wastewater public utility shall not be incorporated into the rate for water or wastewater service but shall be shown as a separate item on the utility's bills to ⁵ customers in such Municipality or County.

If a utility utilizes the base facility and usage charge rate structure and does not have a Commission authorized vacation rate, the utility shall bill the customer the base facility charge regardless of whether there is any usage.

- 16.0 <u>DELINQUENT BILLS</u> When it has been determined that a customer is delinquent in paying any bill, water service may be discontinued after the Company has mailed or presented a written notice to the customer in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 17.0 PAYMENT OF WATERAND WASTEWATERSERVICE BILLS CONCURRENTLY In accordance with Rule 25-30.320(2)(g), Florida Administrative Code, when both water and wastewater service are provided by the Company, payment of any water service bill rendered by the Company to a customer shall not be accepted by the Company without the simultaneous or concurrent payment of any wastewater service bill rendered by the Company.
- 18.0 <u>TERMINATION OF SERVICE</u>- When a customer wishes to terminate service on any premises where water service is supplied by the Company with water service, the Company may require reasonable notice to the Company in accordance with Rule 25-30.325, Florida Administrative Code.

- 25.0 METER ACCURACY REQUIREMENTS All meters used by the company should conform to the provisions of Rule 25-30.262, Florida Administrative Code.

Note: The Company serves an area that is almost entirely builtout and does not presently have any detailed service availability policy for developers.

- 1. Application for the installation of new meters and service connections require the existence of a valid building/plumbing permit and payment of all fee's prior to installation of meter and water being turned on. Manatee County Resolution R-95-219 effective 10/1/95, Sunny Shore Backflow Policy effective 3/1/92 and applicable laws, regulations and codes require the installation of a Double Check Valve assembly device at the service connection, minimum clearance 6" from meter box, and vacuum breakers on all hose connections. Meter installation time is ten days to two weeks or as soon as possible after the above conditions are met.
- 2. All Backflow Prevention devices must be re-certified annually in order for the premise to remain in compliance with appropriate laws, codes and policies. Failure to comply shall mean disruption of service until such time as the premise comes into compliance. Turn off or turn on field charge will apply. It is not the responsibility of SSWC to remind the property owner to have them inspected. If at any time, upon inspection, they are found in non-compliance we will remind you of your responsibility to have it re-certified. This will be done prior to any other action being taken.
