To minimize any AFP ___ ---- regulatory lag that may occur, we request that you file the CAF _____ above no later than July 31, 1996. Because of the difficulty in scheduling hearing dates it is not anticipated that an CMU _____ extension of this filing date will be granted. CTR ____
