RE: AGENDA ITEM #3, PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 25-6.035, ADEQUACY OF SUPPLY 960214-EU

An out-of-time comment was received from Florida Cities in which concern was expressed that the requirements of the proposed rule might be interpreted to require the stated reserve margins to be maintained during an emergency.

In a conference call involving Florida Cities' attorney, Cindy Bogorad, Roland Floyd, Cindy Miller and myself, it was pointed out that the purpose expressed in paragraph (1) in the rule language itself was to

meet all reasonable demands for service and provide a reasonable reserve for emergencies. [e.s.]

In staff's view, that precluded an interpretation that the same requirements had to be maintained <u>during</u> an emergency. Florida Cities indicated that a clarification by the Commission panel on that point would be helpful in alleviating Florida Cities' concern.
