RE: DOCKET NO. 960011-WS - Investigation of rates of Indiantown Company, Inc. in Martin County for possible overearnings.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission should recognize \$27,076 in projected water revenue which exceeds Indiantown's maximum authorized ROE of 10.43%. The wastewater system will earn below its authorized range of ROE by \$118,696. The utility, as a whole, will earn 8.44% on equity, which is below its authorized range of ROE.

Issue 2: Recommendation that the appropriate disposition of the water service revenues of \$118,066, on an annual basis, subject to refund with interest in accordance with Rule 25-30.360, is that the corporate undertaking should be released and the utility allowed to retain the revenues.
