Issue 2: Recommendation that the rate base, which for transfer purposes reflects the net book value, is \$7,377 for the water system as of April 11, 1996.






Issue 3: Recommendation that a positive acquisition adjustment should not be included in the calculation of rate base for transfer purposes.

Issue 4: Recommendation that Crystal River should continue charging the rates approved for this utility system. Additionally, the deposit charges requested by the utility should be approved as modified. The tariff reflecting the change in ownership should be effective for services provided or connections made on or after the stamped approval date. The portion of the order concerning the approval of the deposit charges should be issued as proposed agency action.
