

After reviewing the application in the above referenced docket, the staff has identified the following deficiencies, which need to be corrected.

- 1. As required by Rule 25-30.035(9), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), provide a description of the territory proposed to be served, using township, range and section references as specified in Rule 25-30.030(2). Although a description was provided, part of the description is not in compliance with the above mentioned rule. The problem areas in the territory description that need to be corrected are the commencement point (Kingsland Country Drive is not located on our map), references that are not located on the Florida DOT Marion County map, and the last distance to the POB is missing. Please see Attachment A for details. Also, we have included a copy of "Instructions for Preparation of Territory Description and Map" for your convenience. Please provide an updated territory description.
- 2. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(i), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), provide one copy of the official county tax assessment map or other map showing township, range, and section, with a scale such as 1"=200' or 1"=400', with the proposed territory plotted thereon by use of metes and bounds or quarter sections, and with a defined reference point of beginning. Please label all angles and distances on the map.
- 3. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(n), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the utility must provide a statement regarding the projected impact of the extension on the utility's monthly rates and service availability charges. The statement of "Each of our systems have separate service availability charges so this particular extension might require some changes." is not sufficient. What service availability charges apply to this system, and does the utility intend to file a service availability case?

Letter to Mr. Thompson March 10, 1997 4. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(b), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the utility must provide a statement showing the financial and technical ability of the utility to provide service and the need for service in the area requested. The utility's financial statement of "Our current annual report should contain the necessary financial information." is insufficient. A reference to another document is not sufficient. Each docket must be complete in and of itself. Please provide a brief summary of the financial ability of the utility. 5. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(o), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the utility must provide the original and two copies of the sample tariff sheets reflecting the additional service area. Since the territory description will change, your tariff will change. Please resubmit. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(p), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the utility . must return their certificate for possible amendment. Please provide Certificate No. 347-W. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(j), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), provide a statement describing the capacity of the existing lines, the capacity of the treatment facilities and the design capacity of the proposed extension. The design capacity of the proposed extension was not listed. Please state the capacity of the proposed extension in gallons per day. On Exhibit B of the application the stated capacity of the plant design is .570 mgd. Please provide the peak flows at the water treatment plant, so it can be determined if the water plant has the capacity to serve the extension. Please file an original and five copies of the requested information, one map and the original and two copies of the tariff no later than April 10, 1997 with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. - 2 -
