Does the "need" portion of the Florida Electric Power Plant Siting Act allow merchant plants to be certified? (A merchant plant is a non-utility power plant constructed without a utility applicant and there is no obligation by customers of any utility to pay rates based in part on the costs or prices of that plant.) Can a merchant plant be build without certification pursuant to the Power Plant Siting Act? If the answer to both of the above is "no", does the Florida Electric Power Plant Siting Act frustrate the FERC policy for a competitive wholesale market by restricting entry?
