



NOTICE OF NEED DETERMINATION HEARING ON PROPOSED ELECTRICAL POWER PLANT TO FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS DOCKET NO. 971059-EI

IN RE: PETITION TO DETERMINE NEED FOR EXISTING TIGER BAY ELECTRICAL POWER PLANT AND NOMINAL ELECTRICAL CAPACITY INCREASE TO THAT PLANT
FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION

NOTICE is hereby given that the Florida Public Service Commission will hold a public hearing in the above docket at the time and place listed below. All persons who wish to be heard are urged to be present at the beginning of the hearing on Monday, October 20, 1997.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing will be for the Commission to take final action to determine the need, pursuant to Sections 403.511-519, Florida Statutes, for the existing Tiger Bay power plant located in Polk County, Florida, to permit any interconnection or modification to the plant to the mother line to permit members of the public who are not parties to the need determination proceeding the opportunity to present testimony concerning its mother line and for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate. All witnesses shall be subject to examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 10, Florida Statutes, Section 403.519, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-22, Florida Administrative Code.

Under Section 403.511, Florida Statutes, the Commission is the sole forum for the determination of need for the electrical power plant and associated facilities, including the proposed plant. In the Commission must take into account the need for electric system reliability and integrity; the need for adequate electric generation, load, and whether the proposed plant is the most cost-effective alternative available. The Commission must also expressly consider alternatives taken by the utility which is reasonably available to Florida Power Corporation which might mitigate the need for the Tiger Bay facility and reduce the need for the proposed plant. The Commission's resolution of need for the Tiger Bay facility shall create a presumption of reasonableness for the hearing officer's consideration in the issuance of a final order.

Only issues relating to the need for the power plant and associated facilities will be heard at the October 20, 1997 hearing. Separate public hearings will be held before the Division of Administrative Hearings to determine environmental and other impacts of the existing plant and associated facilities.

Members of the public who are not parties to the need determination proceeding will have an opportunity to present testimony regarding the impact of the plant and associated facilities. All members of the public who wish to offer testimony should be present at the beginning of the hearing. Testimony will be open and will be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

Anyone wishing to become a party to the need determination proceeding should file an appropriate petition pursuant to Rule 25-22.09, Florida Administrative Code with the Director of the Commission's Division of Records and Reporting of the address listed above. Copies of the petition should be filed with all parties. Those wishing to intervene in these proceedings, under Rule 25-22.09, Florida Administrative Code, must be represented by an attorney of record and must file a petition for intervention with the Director of the Commission's Division of Records and Reporting of the address listed above. The intervenor must file a petition for intervention with the Director of the Commission's Division of Records and Reporting of the address listed above if the intervenor is entitled to participate in the proceeding by reason of constitutional or statutory right pursuant to Commission rule, or if the substantial interests of the intervenor are subject to determination by the Commission.

GENERAL LOCATION AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Tiger Bay facility is an existing fossil fuel 220 MW combined cycle generating facility located near Ft. Meade in Polk County, Florida. Florida Power Corporation proposes to increase the plant capacity of the facility to greater than 76 megawatts.

The purpose of this prehearing conference will be to consider (1) the simplification of the issues; (2) the identification of the positions of the parties; (3) the possibility of settling statements of fact and/or documents which will avoid unnecessary proof; (4) the identification of exhibits; (5) the establishment of an order of witnesses; and (6) any other matters as may aid in the disposition of the action.

JURISDICTION

Jurisdiction over this determination of need is vested in the Commission by Chapter 10, Florida Statutes, and Section 403.519, Florida Statutes. The proceeding will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 10, Florida Statutes, as well as Chapter 25-22, Florida Administrative Code.
