By its request, Wireless One seeks the opportunity to address the Commission at its January 6, 1998, Agenda Conference, regarding its concerns with the staff's recommendation. Attached to Wireless One's Request was a Memorandum in Support of its Request. On January 2, 1998, Sprint responded to Wireless One's filing. While Sprint does not object to Wireless One's filing of a Request for Oral Argument, per se, Sprint states that it does object to the attached Memorandum of Law. Sprint asserts that the Memorandum is actually a supplemental brief and response to the staff recommendation.
