That the granting of the amendment to the certificate of authorization of the existing system will result in the system being in competition with, and/or a duplication of, the system of the City of Longwood. The City of Longwood has a system that is adequate to meet the reasonable needs of the public in the subject area and is able to provide reasonably adequate service.
