Questions for the SJWMD:

1. According to the Consumptive Use Permit for the Sabal Point Country Club, Sabal Point has been required to submit annual progress reports documenting negotiations with Sanlando Utilities regarding the provision of reclaimed water. Has Sabal Point provided these progress reports? If so, please provide a copy.
2. In addition, the Sabal Point Country Club has been required to submit cost estimates for an economic feasibility assessment for the use of reclaimed water to irrigate Sabal Point's property as well as a proposed implementation plan to accept reclaimed wastewater for irrigation by January 1, 1998. Has Sabal Point submitted this study? If so, please provide a copy.
3. Further, the Wekiva Golf Club has been required to submit annual reports on or before January 15 of each year, documenting effort made by Wekiva to accept reclaimed water from reclaimed water suppliers. Please provide copies of these reports.
4. Please provide a copy of the Consumptive Use Permit (CUP) for Lake Brantley Plant Corp.
5. Does Sanlando have a Water Conservation Program on file with the SJRWMD? If so, please provide a copy.
6. What is the average water usage for the following golf courses:
Sweetwater Golf Course
Sabal Point Golf Course
Wekiva Golf Course
Lake Brantley Golf Course
7. What is the average water usage for water customers of Sanlando?
8. Does the SJRWMD have a definition of economically feasible? If so, please state the definition.
9. Please provide an explanation as to how the SJRWMD determines economic feasibility for potential reuse end users.
