Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby submits its Statement of the Issues and Positions to be taken up at the hearing scheduled to commence on February 25, 1998 in the above docket.

**CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY**

**Issue No. 1:** What was the actual true-up amount for the October 1996 - September 1997 period for Tampa Electric?

**Tampa Electric's Position:** An overrecovery of \$1,067,112, including interest. (Witness: Bryant)

**Issue No. 2:** What is the appropriate projected end of period total net true-up amount for Tampa Electric for the period October 1997 - March 1998?

**Tampa Electric's Position:** An underrecovery of \$84,452, including interest. (Witness: Bryant)

**Issue No. 3:** What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors to be applied by Tampa Electric during the period April 1998 March 1999?

**Tampa Electric's Position:** 0.011 cents per KWH for Interruptible, 0.165 cents per KWH for Residential, 0.161 cents per KWH for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service, 0.135 cents per KWH for General Service Demand and Electric Vehicle -
